

Public Works - Convenience Center

For the convenience of city residents, a dumpster is located at the Public Works **Florida Ave.** compound (Entrance alongside of the garage.) This dumpster may be used by City of Bridgeton residents on **Saturdays only** between **7:00am - 3:00pm**. One trip per household is allowed. Proof of residency is required in the form of a valid NJ License with Bridgeton address or a picture ID accompanied by a copy of the tax bill or lease agreement showing proof of residency. The following items will be accepted at the **Convenience Center**:

Items Accepted:

- Excess Household trash (bagged)
- Grass Clippings (bagged)
- Household furniture (excluding White Goods or Tires)
- Computers (monitors, keyboards, laptops, computer wire & mouse controllers accepted) NOTE: limited to six complete units per resident
- VCRS, Stereos & Televisions (including floor models)
- Newspaper & mixed paper (tied & bundled)
- Corrugated Cardboard (broken down, tied & bundled)
- Fluorescent bulbs (Compact bulbs, 4', 6' & 8' tubes)
- Batteries (alkaline, 9-volt, cell phone & dry cell—NO Automobile batteries)
- Antifreeze and motor oil
- Wood – No longer than 4' in length and tied in bundles (limit 4 bundles - each weighing 30 lbs. or less)
- Wire fencing – No longer than 4' in length and tied in bundles (limit 4 bundles – each weighing 30 lbs. or less)
- Bikes

Items Not Accepted:

- Tires
- White Goods (including Washers, Dryers, Refrigerators, Dishwashers, Hot Water Heaters, Stoves, Air Conditioners, Microwaves, etc...)
- Construction Waste
- Commercial or Business Waste
- Hazardous Materials Waste
- Gas tanks, Car Batteries or any automobile parts
- Propane Tanks
- Fire Extinguishers
- Lawn mowers or any other lawn equipment including weed whackers
- Limbs, brush, bushes or leaves
- No chain link fencing – or scrap metal of any kind

Acceptable transportation for bringing trash to the convenience center includes:

Pick-up trucks, SUVs, Cars and Vans only

NO box trucks, U-hauls or large trailer loads!

Small trailers can be used for excess household garbage and furniture only and will be accepted at the sole discretion of the Enforcement Officer on duty!

The use of this dumpster will be strictly monitored.

You will be required to show your proof of residency.

Limit one trip per household.
