(9) Manner of advertising and/or conducting proposed sale

(On the above lines the applicant will make a statement as to how the proposed sale will be advertised, whether by distribution of hand bills, circulars, etc., or through the use of newspaper, directmail, radio, bill-board, etc. advertising; and also as to whether the proposed sale will be conducted in the regular retail selling manner or by public auction.)
