

CITY COUNCIL MEETING

A Special Meeting of the Bridgeton City Council was held on Tuesday, February 23, 2010 at 4:30 p.m., City of Bridgeton Police and Municipal Court Complex, 330 Fayette Street, Bridgeton, New Jersey in Council Chambers.
