

CITY COUNCIL MEETING

A meeting of the Bridgeton City Council was held on Tuesday, June 22, 2010 at 6:30 p.m., City of Bridgeton Police and Municipal Court Complex, 330 Fayette Street, Bridgeton, New Jersey in Council Chambers.

The meeting was called to order by Acting Council President William D. Spence.

The Statement of Meeting Notice was read by City Clerk, Darlene J. Richmond, "Adequate notice of this meeting pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 giving the time, date, location and agenda to the extent known has been given in the following manner:

1. By posting notice of said meeting on the bulletin board at City Hall Annex, 181 East Commerce Street, Bridgeton, New Jersey on June 18, 2010, 4:30 p.m.

2. By mailing such notice to the News of Cumberland County and the Press on June 18, 2010, at 4:30 p.m." The invocation delivered and flag salute was led by Councilman Salvatore.

Acting Council President Spence announced this time for public portion of the meeting.

It was moved by Ms. Lugardo and second by Mr. Salvatore that the meeting be opened to the public for any one desiring to be heard which motion was carried.

Acting Pres. Spence opened the meeting to the public.

No one desiring to be heard, it was moved by Mr. Salvatore and second by Mr. Thompson to close the public portion of the meeting which motion was carried.

Acting Pres. Spence closed the public portion of the meeting.

Acting Pres. Spence read the Consent Agenda Statement:

All matters listed under items G-1, through items G-9 are considered routine and will be enacted upon by one motion, if discussion is desired that item will be removed from the consent agenda and will be acted upon separately with item G-1 being removed.

It was moved by Ms. Lugardo seconded by Mr. Thompson that the following Resolutions listed under the consent agenda be adopted, which motion was carried by unanimous roll call vote. The original resolutions may be found in the Resolution Book.

Acting Pres. Spence presented the Schedule of Bills in the amount of \$164,992.04 all members having received copies.

It was moved by Mr. Thompson and second by Ms. Lugardo that the Schedule of Bills be approved and warrants be drawn on their various accounts and appropriations, which motion was carried by unanimous roll call vote. The original schedule may be found in the files under "S" Schedule of Bills.
