

CITY COUNCIL MEETING

A meeting of the Bridgeton City Council was held on Tuesday, June 28, 2011 at 6:30 p.m., City of Bridgeton Police and Municipal Court Complex, 330 Fayette Street, Bridgeton, New Jersey in Council Chambers.

The meeting was called to order by Council President William D. Spence.
